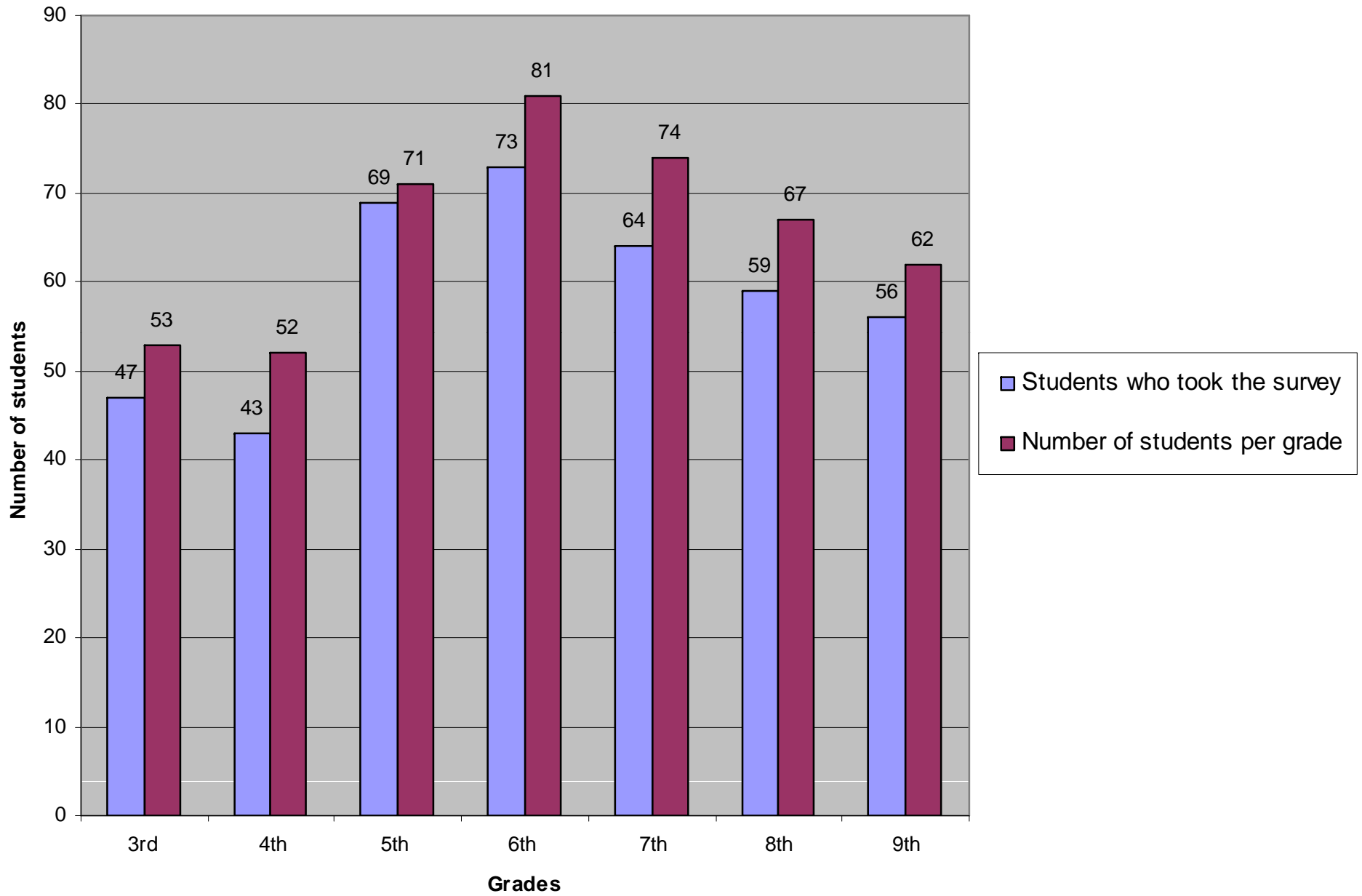

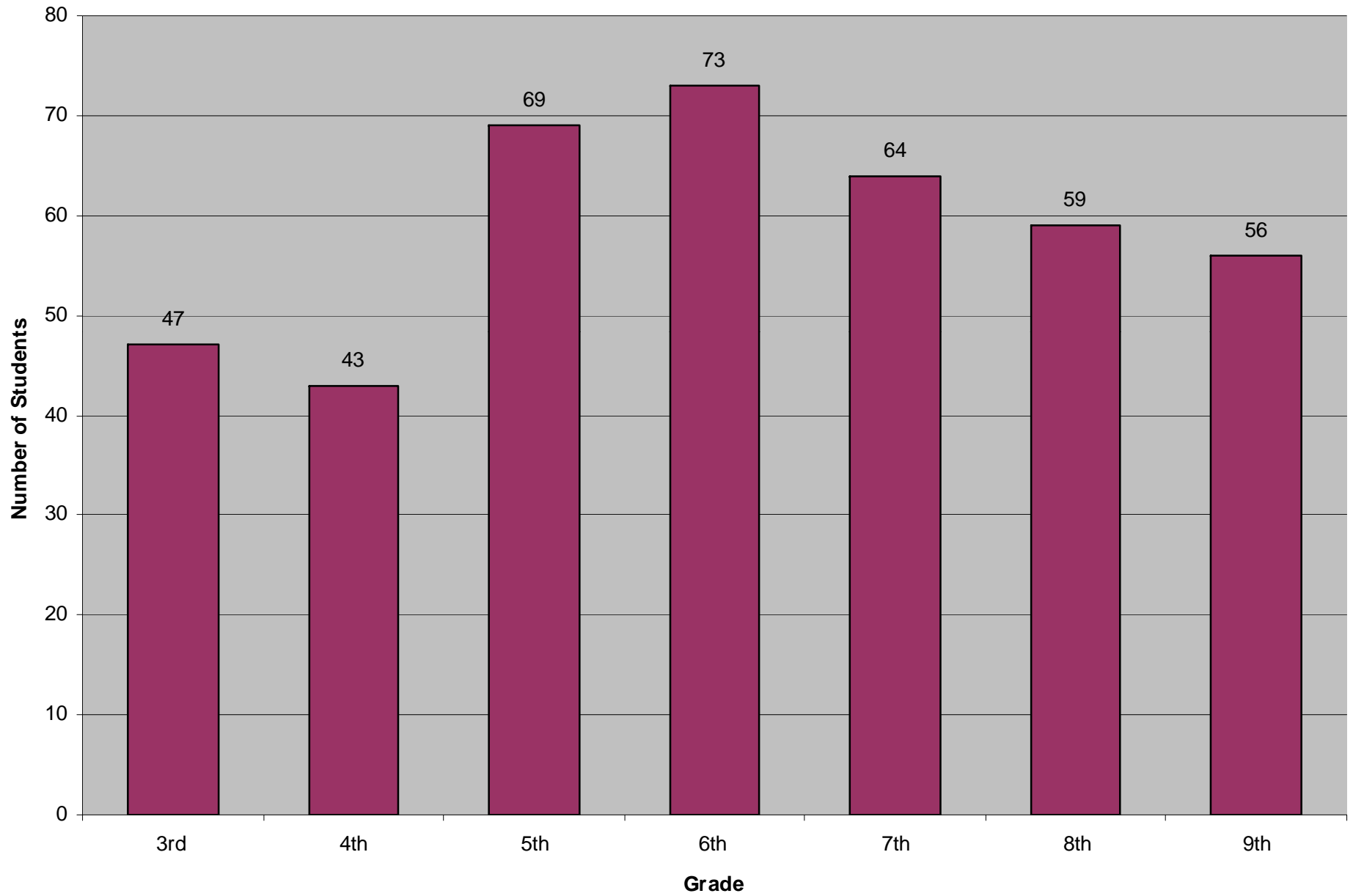

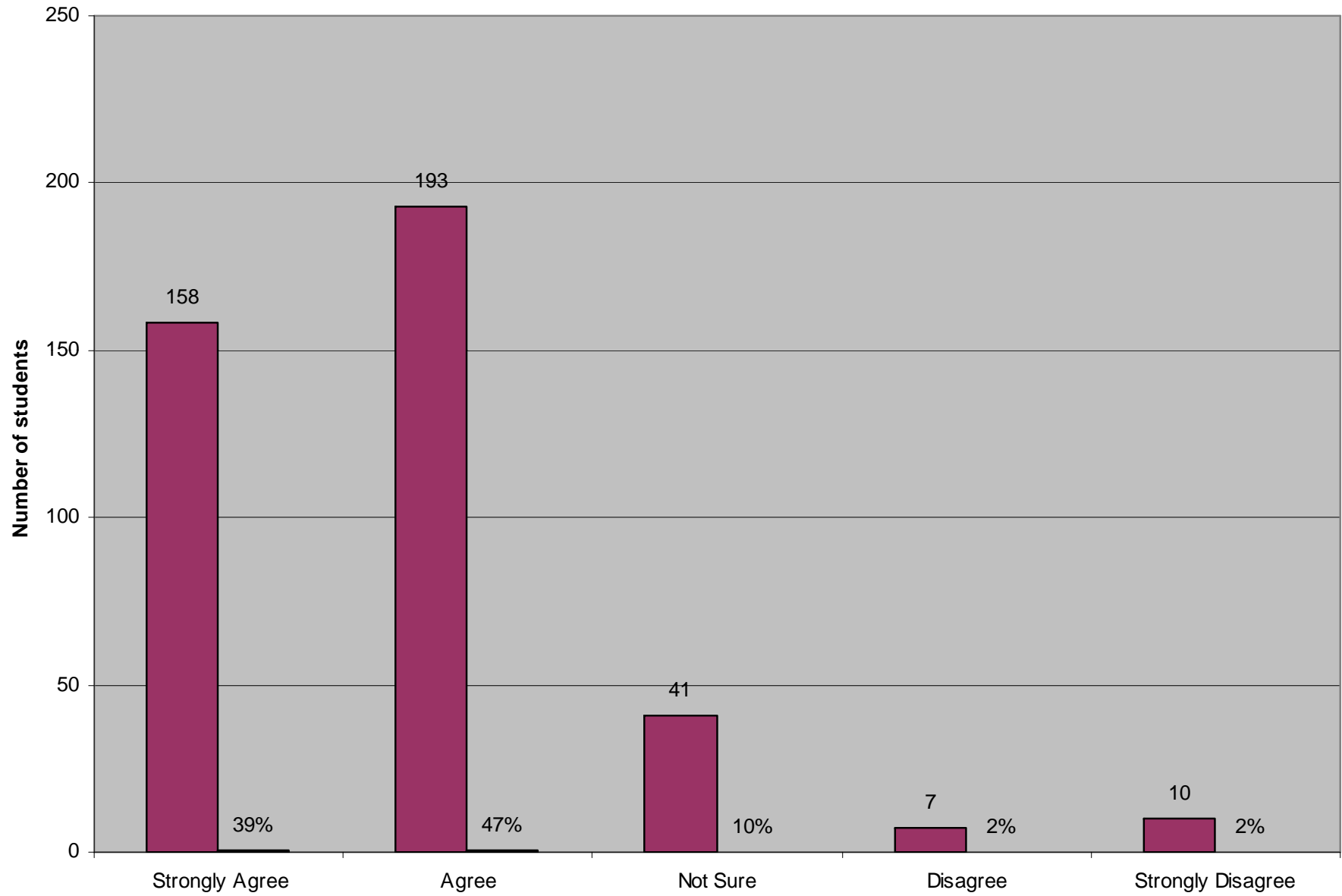
Survey Responses vs. Number of Students



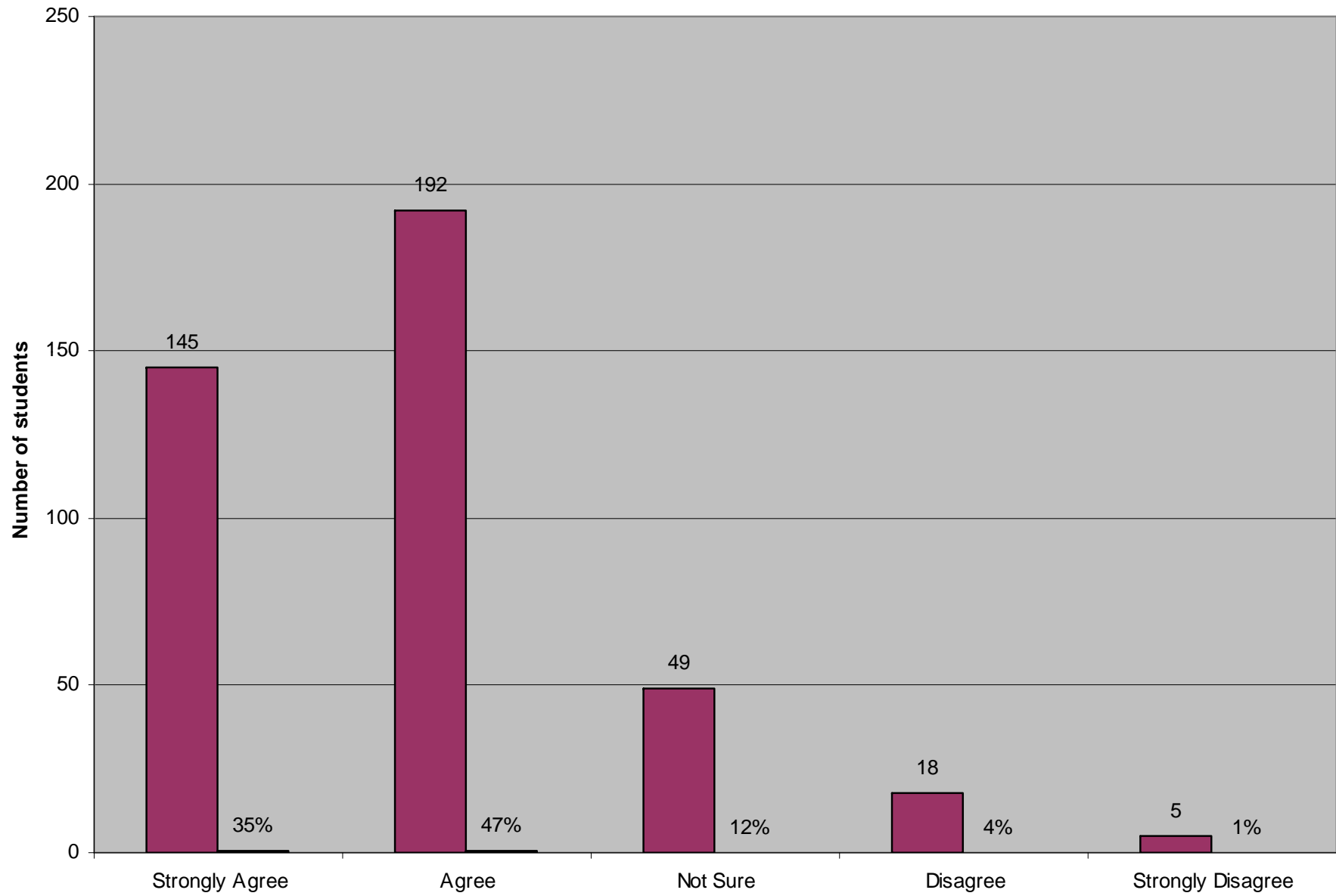
What grade are you in?



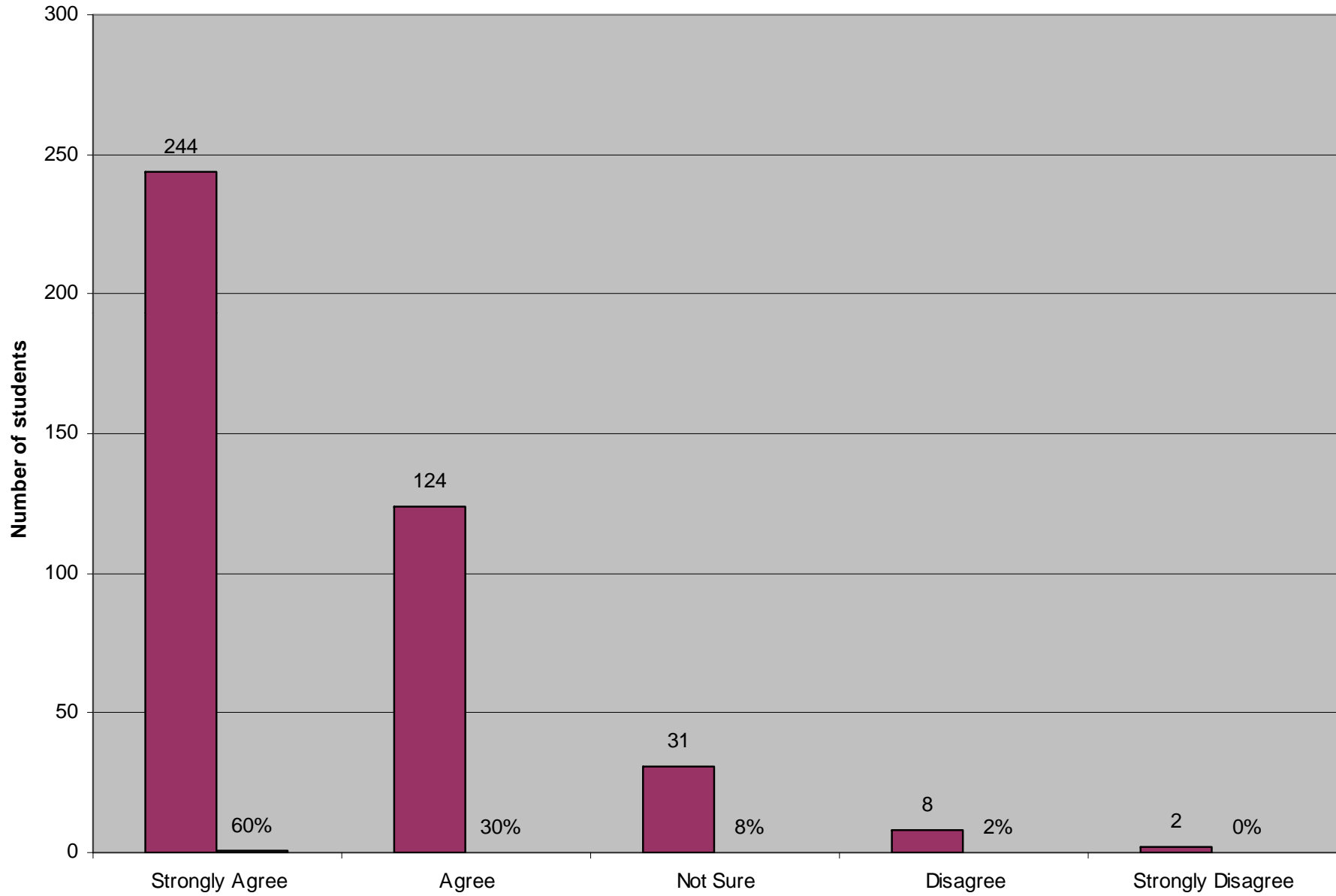
My teachers help me when I need help with my homework.



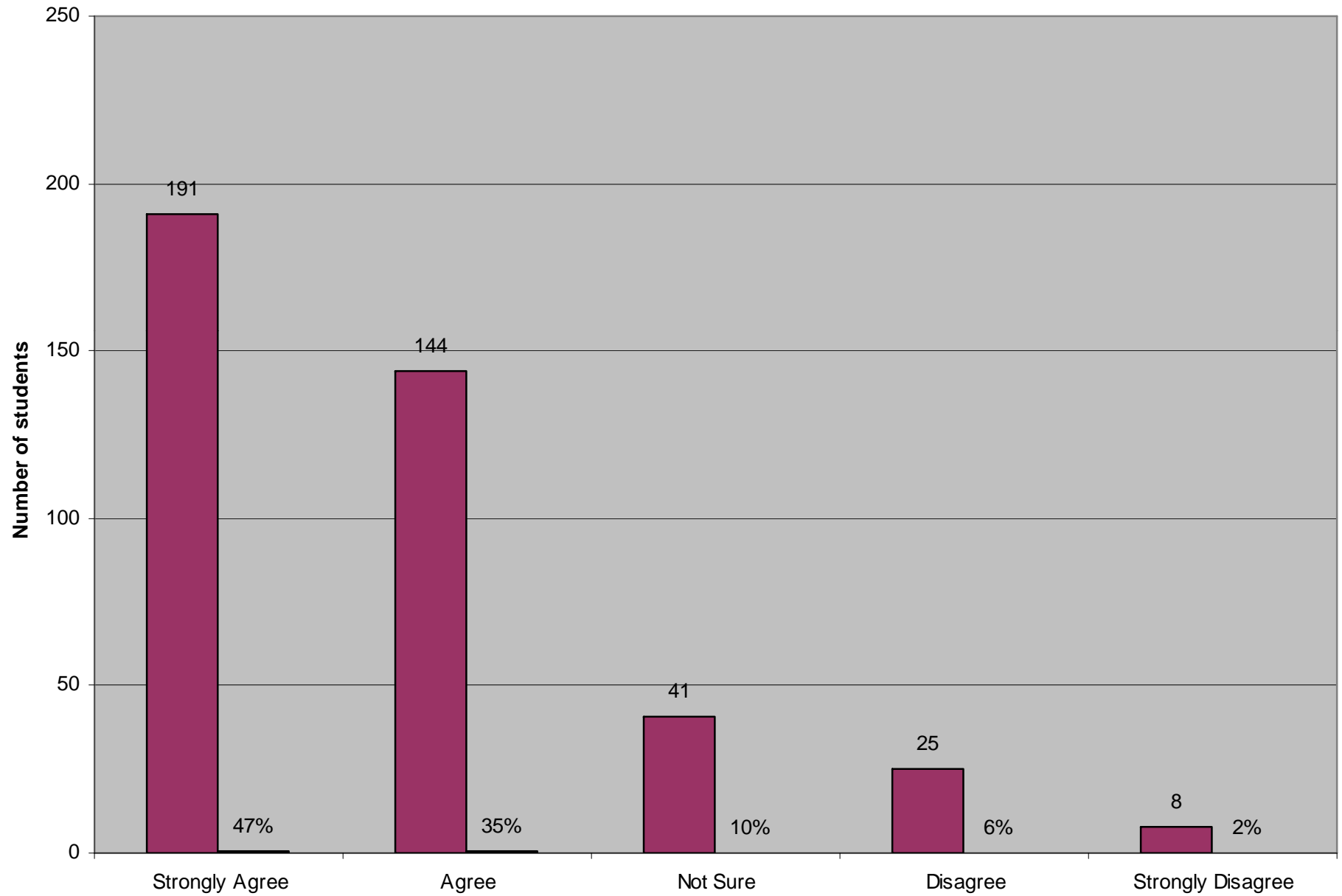
