Originally 200 surveys were sent out to randomized parents from both OPA and MOPA, but the response rate was only 32 surveys or 16%. The survey was then sent out for all parents to participate in. The survey response for MOPA was 91 surveys or approx. 25% of surveys sent out (359).

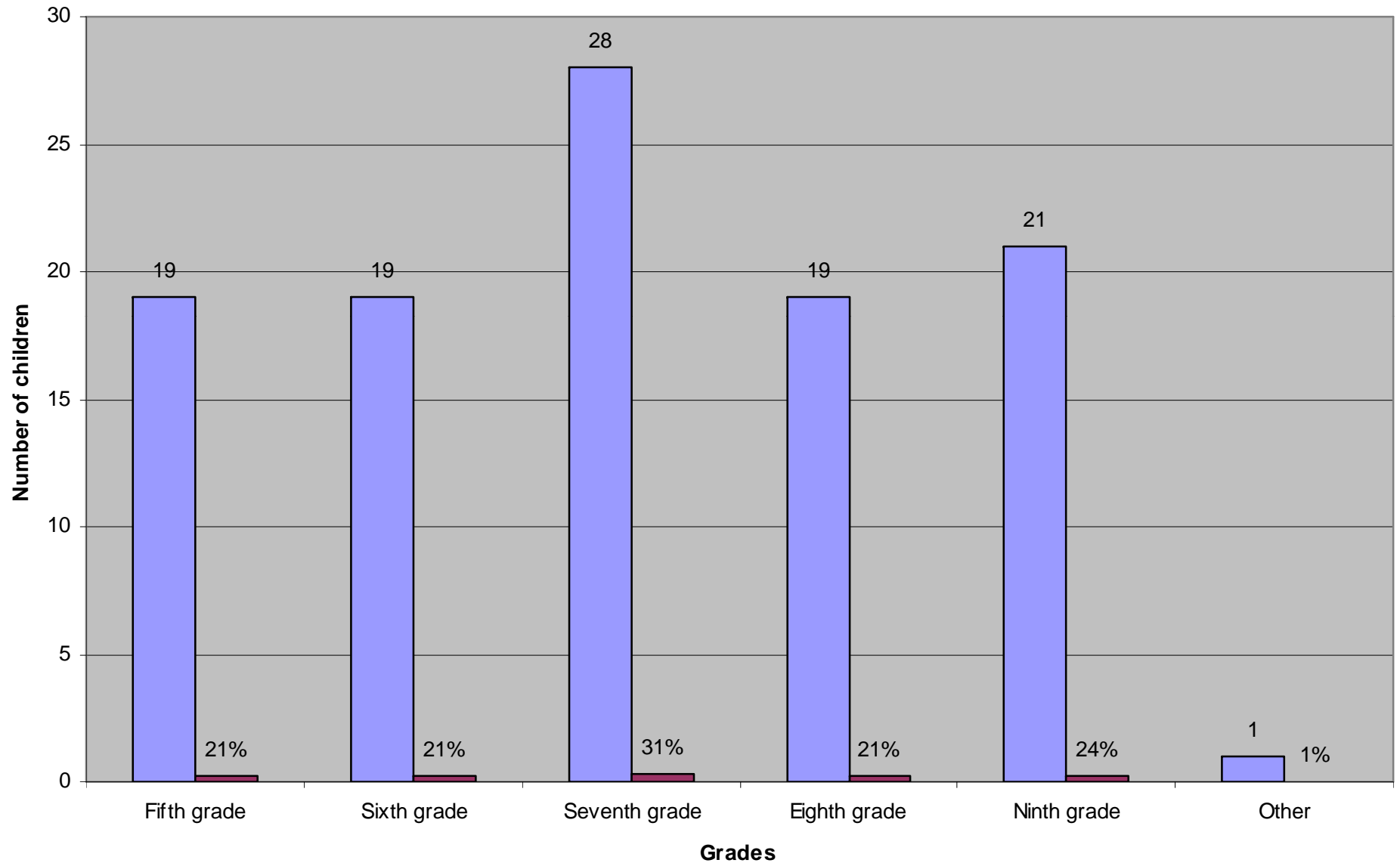

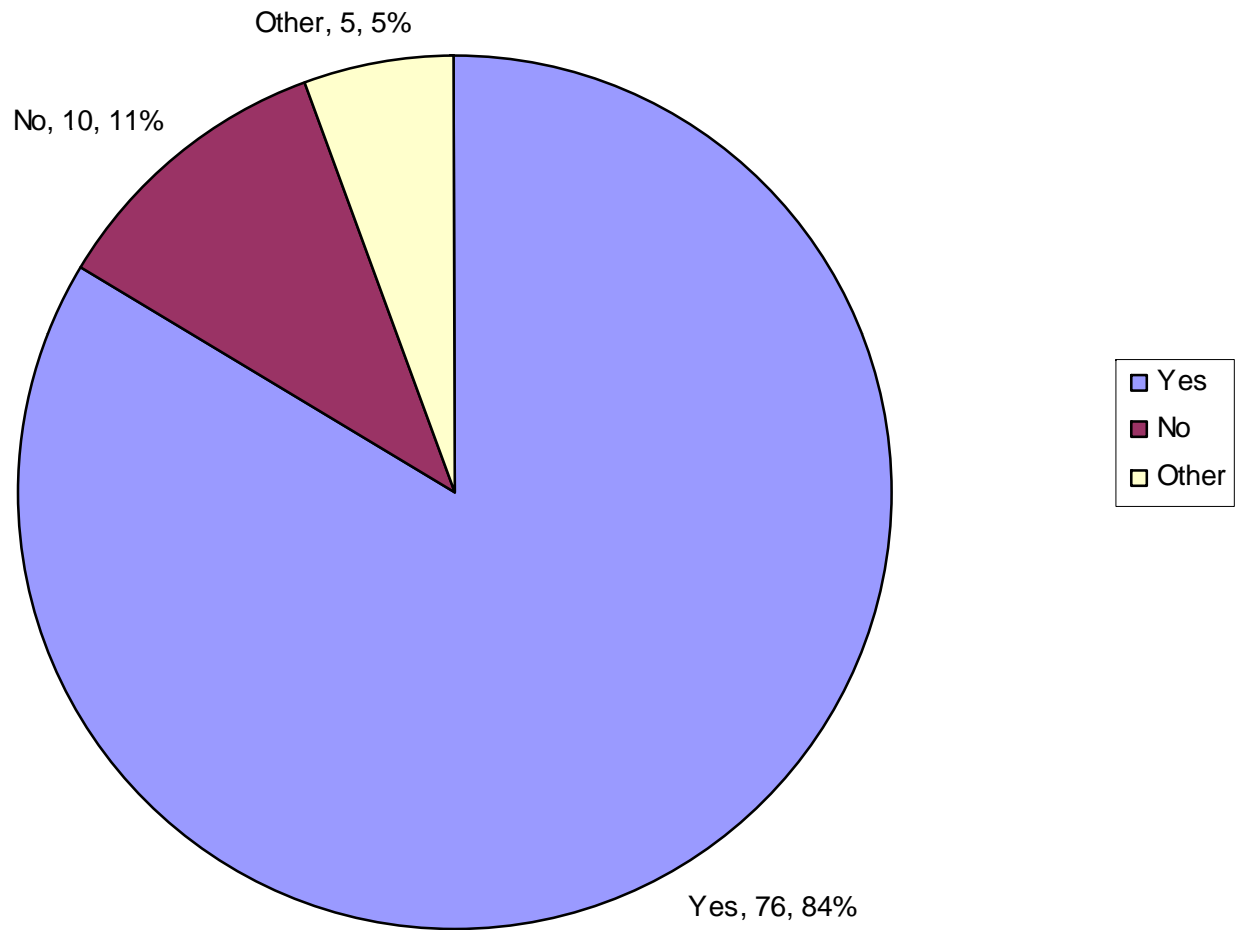
I check the school's website.



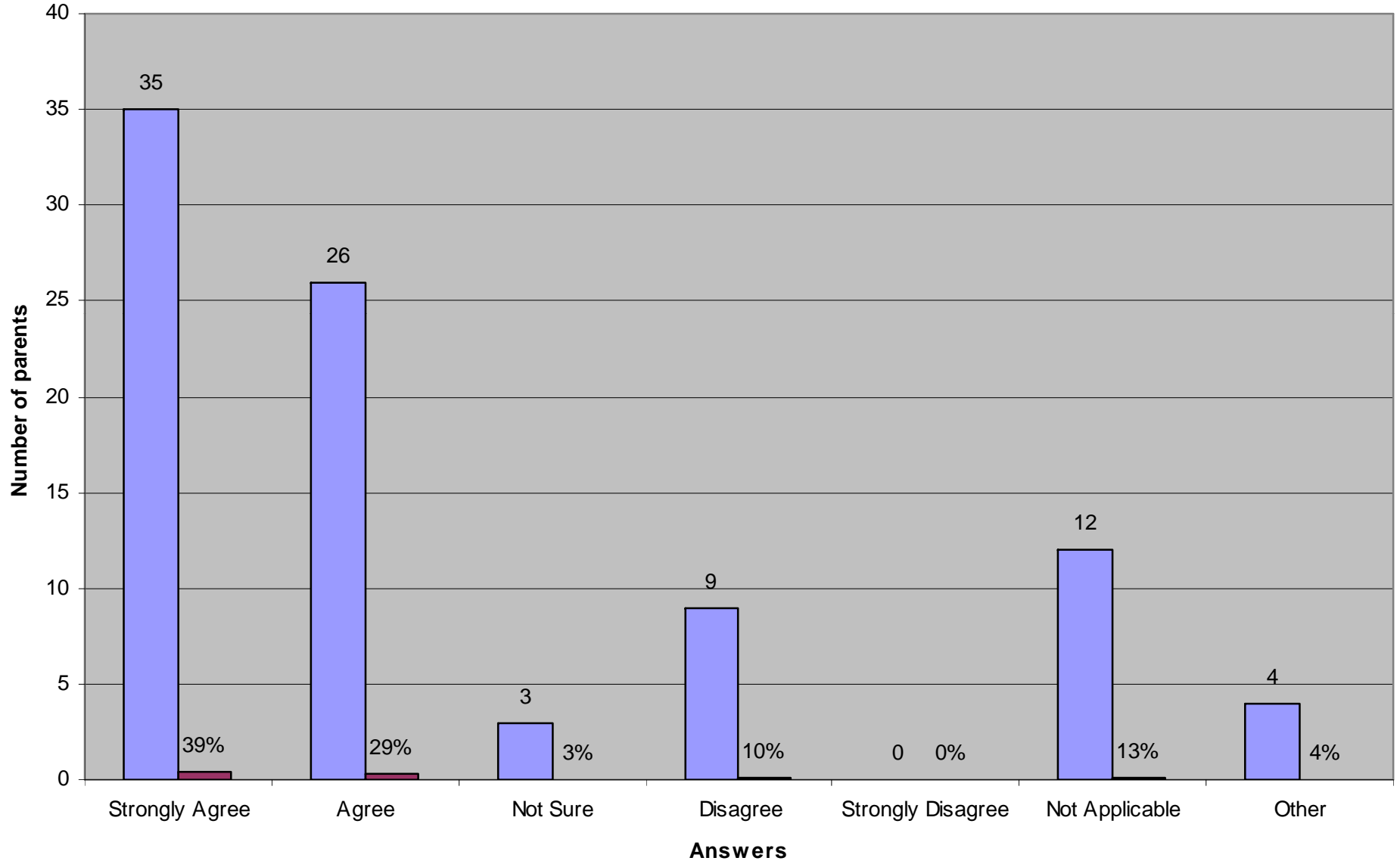
I login to powerschool to check my child's grades.



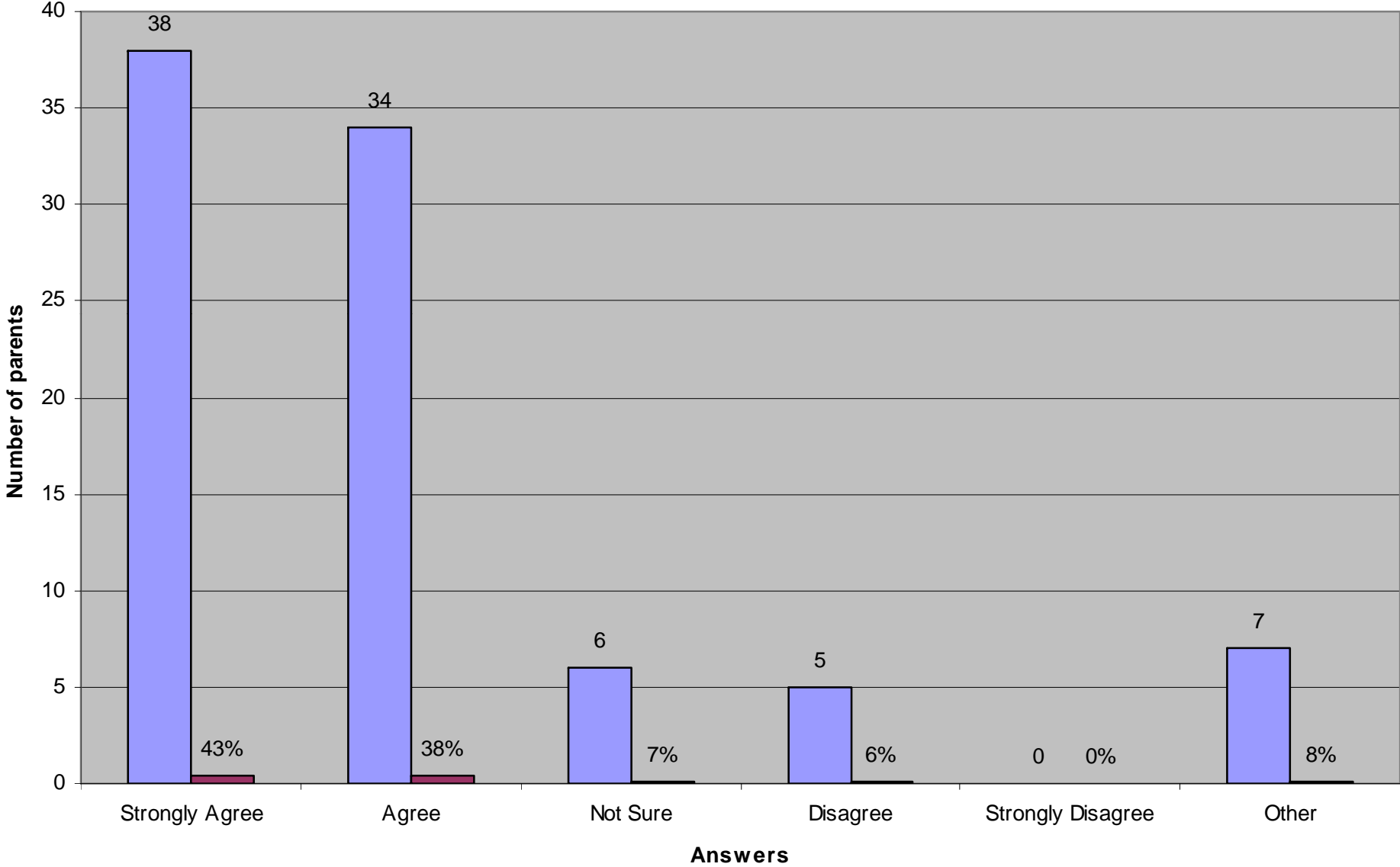
I read the monthly classroom newsletters.



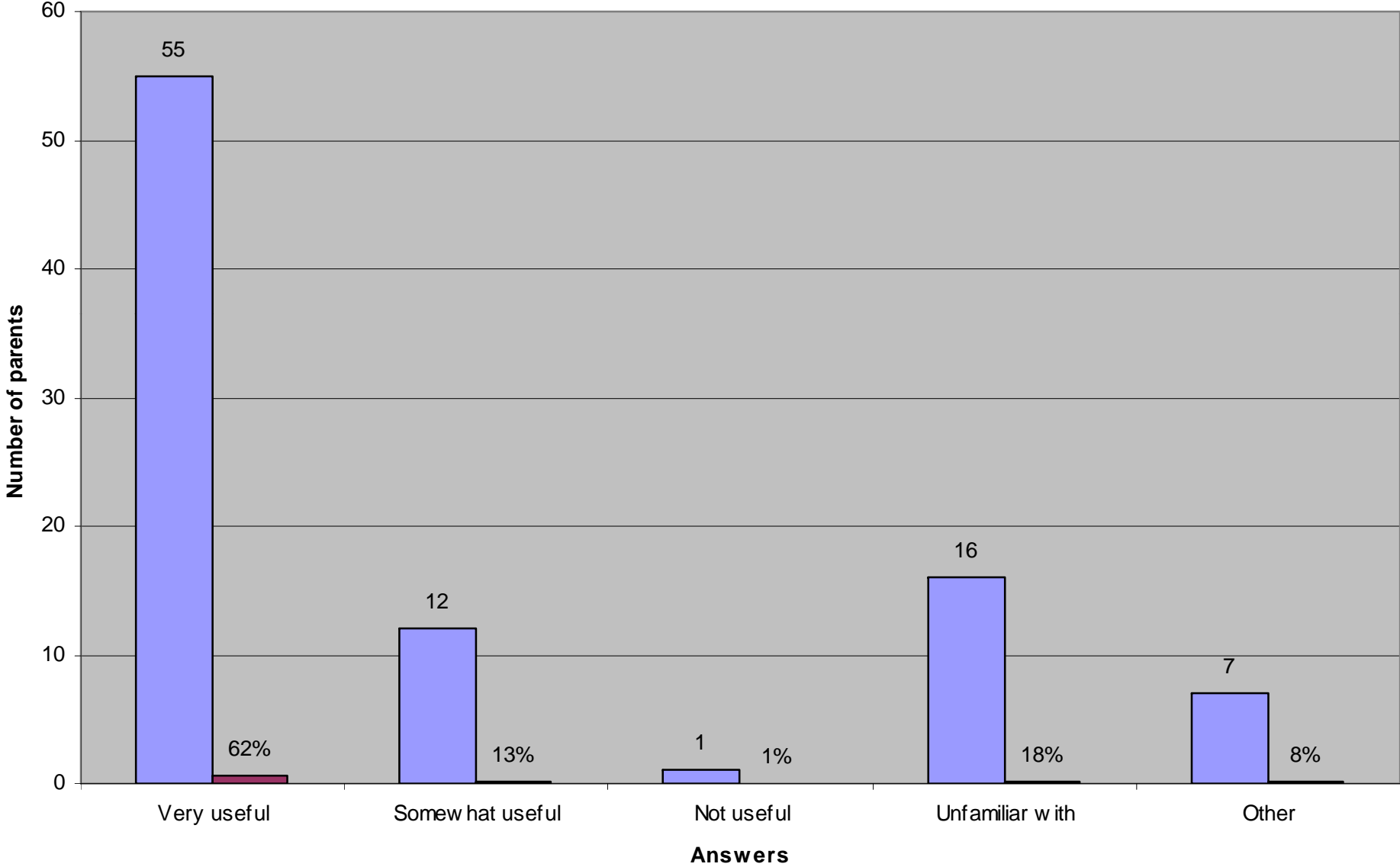
Earning detention motivates my child(ren) to follow school rules.



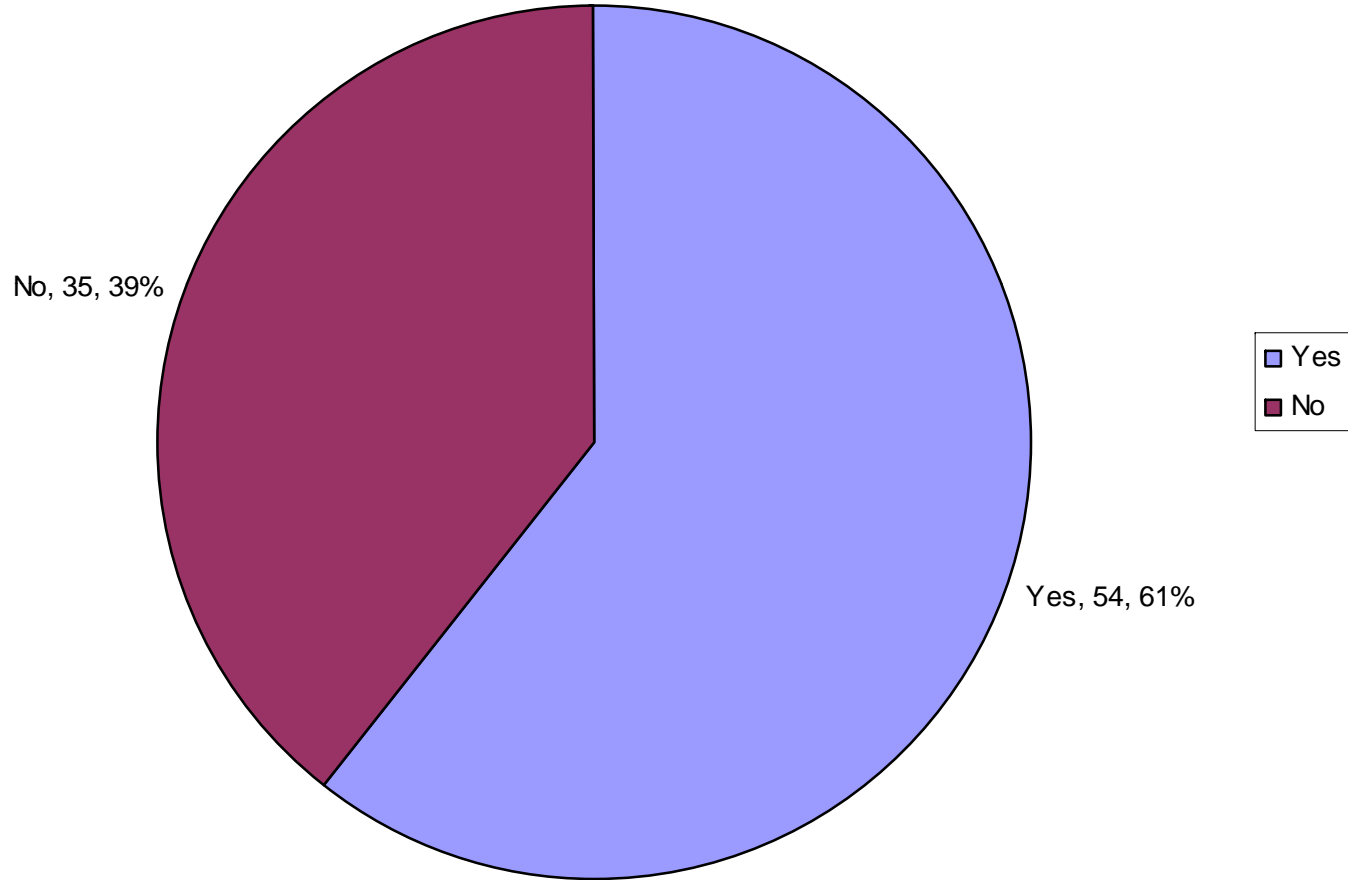
Homework Recovery motivates my child(ren) to get his/her homework done on time.



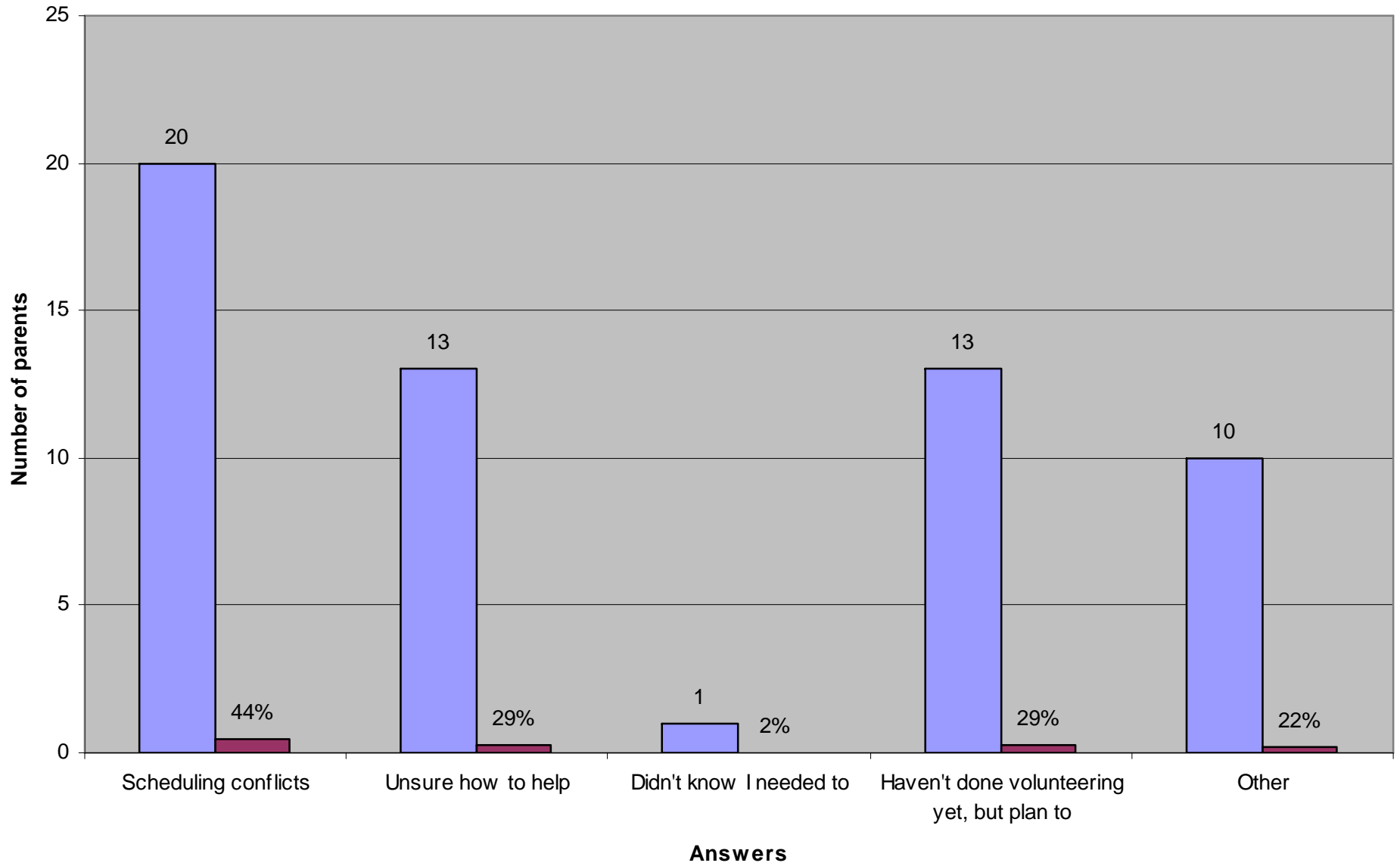
How useful is after school tutoring (staying after to get help from a teacher)?
