Utah code Ann - 53A-11-101.5 authorizes the building administrator to issue a notice of compulsory education violation to a parent. Guardian for a student who is a least six (6) years old but under the age of fifteen (15), if the student is absent without a valid excuse at least five (5) times during the school year.

1. **Fail to meet** with the school authorities designated in the Notice of Compulsory Education violation to discuss the school-age child's attendance problems;
2. **Unexcused absences.** Fail to prevent the school aged child from being absent without a valid excuse five or more times during the remainder of the year.
