Appeals shall be reviewed and exceptions granted based on extenuating circumstances and student improvement.
 Extended Field Trip Behavior Expectations: Students are a representative of Ogden Preparatory Academy, and as such, they should adhere strictly to all Ogden Preparatory Academy policies and procedures, including those set forth in the student handbook. This includes, but is not limited to, the policies regarding use, possession, or consumption of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs. Students shall follow the instructions of the organizers and supervisors of the trip; Students shall participate fully in all arranged activities and excursions while on the trip; Students shall not urge, encourage, counsel, further, promote, assist, cause, advise, procure, or abet any other student(s) to violate any Ogden Preparatory Academy policies, procedures or rules of conduct.

I also understand that the trip supervisors may require that the above named student leave the extended field trip as a result of inappropriate behavior, and that the student's parent/guardian will be responsible for expenses incurred regarding this travel and/or may need to travel a significant distance to pick up the student.
