2018-2019 School Land Trust Plan

Ogden Preparatory Academy was awarded \$116,067 from School Land Trust funds for the 2018-2019 school year. The School Land Trust Plan for the 2018-2019 school year focused on the goal of improving reading and math scores with the following implementations:

- Implemented a comprehensive ELA curriculum, Reading Wonders in Kindergarten through 6th grades.
- A teaching assistant is assigned to work with mathematics at each grade level; that teaching assistant works under the direction of the mathematics specialist.
- The Library was given a budget for improving inventory and circulation.
- Teachers and Staff utilized the Math DIBELS assessment system to analyze student progress.
