

Dear OPA Families:

School Dismissed March 16 through March 27.

Effective this afternoon, the State Health Department has decided to dismiss all Utah Schools for two weeks. The State Board of Education and the State Health Department will reassess the situation at that time and provide additional direction.

A school dismissal means the buildings are open and safe; adults can be in the building and students can come and go in small groups. There should not be any group gatherings. We have been asked to limit visitors and events at the school. Please only come to the school as scheduled or prearranged. We do not have any confirmed cases of Coronavirus in the OPA community.

All events and afterschool programs are discontinued until further notice.

Schedule of Teaching and Learning:

Teachers will be using Monday, March 16th and Tuesday, March 17th to prepare digital lessons aligned with the Utah Core. Then, starting Wednesday, March 18th through Friday, March 27th teachers will facilitate content digitally. Students will be expected to access content each day.

There will be multiple ways for students to access content:

1. Students can use a home device and wifi to access content.
2. Students can come to the school on Wednesday, March 18th to pick up a device for check out for home use. The pick-up schedule is listed below.

Google Chromebook Pick-up Schedule for Wednesday, March 18th:

- Students with last name A-F: 10:00am-11:00am
 - Students with last name G-M: 11:00am-Noon
 - Students with last name N-R: Noon-1:00pm
 - Students with last name S-Z: 1:00pm-2:00pm
3. Students can work daily with their teachers online or at the school by arranging specific blocks of time through direct communication with teachers.

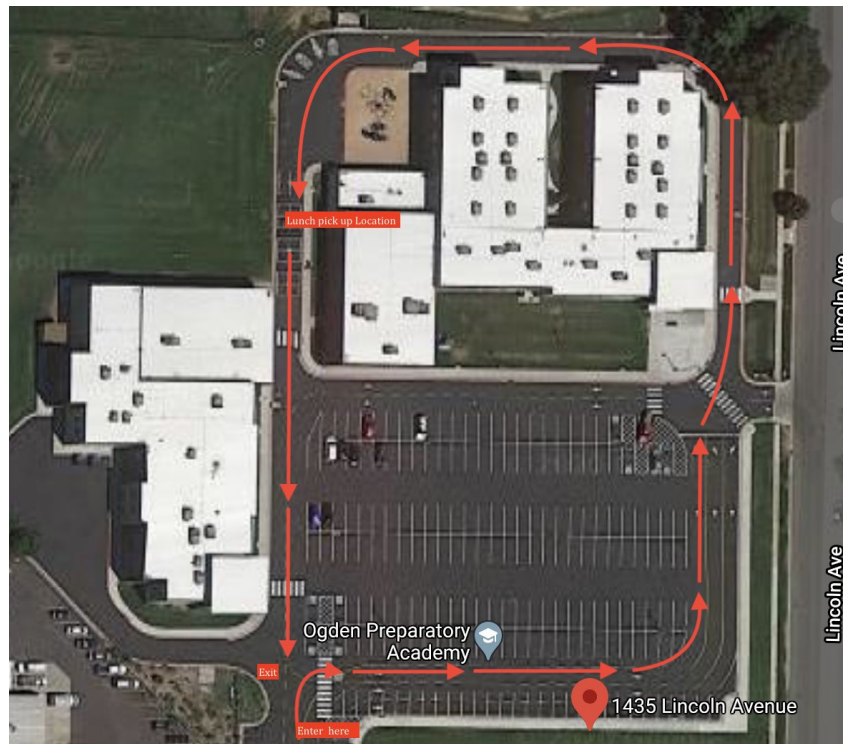
Special Services

- Lunch will be served from 11am-1pm.
- In order to pick up breakfast and lunch, cars should enter off 15th street, drive around the back of the elementary, and exit to 15th street. This will allow for any line that may form. See map below.
