2019-2020 School Land Trust Plan

Ogden Preparatory Academy was awarded \$130,253 from School Land Trust funds for the 2019-2020 school year. The School Land Trust Plan for the 2019-2020 school year focused on the goal of improving reading and math scores with the following implementations:

- Continued implementation of a comprehensive ELA curriculum, Reading Wonders in Kindergarten through 6th grades.
- A vertical math team was created with representatives from each grade level. The vertical
 math team implemented Power Hours in each grade level math class to focus on filling
 gaps and increasing content understanding.

- Interactive whiteboards were installed in some mathematics classrooms to increase student engagement.
- i-Ready mathematics intervention software was implemented in all grades.
- The Library was given a budget for improving inventory and circulation.
