COVID and Quarantines Guidelines:

- 1. Stay home if you are sick. (Students exhibiting symptoms will be sent home.)
- 2. Get vaccinated if you can.
- 3. Mask wearing is encouraged.

Quarantines:

- 1. No quarantine is necessary if one of the following is met:
 - 1. You have been vaccinated,
 - 2. You have had Covid within 90 days,
 - 3. Exposed person was Mask on Mask with the positive person, OR
 - 4. Exposed person was wearing a KN95, or N95 Mask.

2. Quarantine timelines

- 1. Any individual who tests positive will quarantine 10 days from the onset of symptoms or the positive test..
- 2. Exposed individuals will quarantine for 10 days or 7 days with a negative test on the 7th day after the exposure ends.
- 3. Individuals who are living with a person who has tested positive should follow the advice of the Weber County Health Department. Generally, positive cases in the household will require quarantines by household members.
