■ Fast Facts

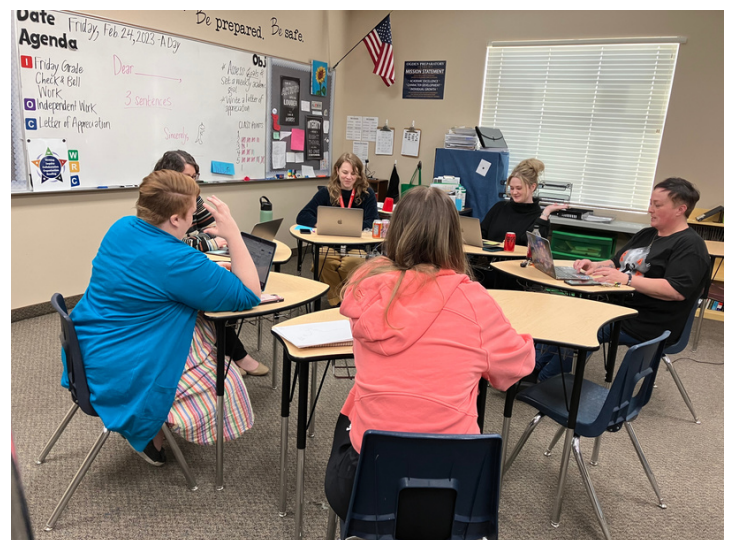
Who
